

# GCSE RESULTS 1999

118 students were on roll in January 1999.

They were entered for an average of 7 GCSEs each.

24% of QK students were awarded 5 or more 'top grades' (A\*-C).

75% passed in 5 or more GCSEs (A\*-G).
